\$125 per student. Students will receive approx 15-20 volunteer hours and a written evaluation as a part of this program.

Applications are due April 15

- This program runs from 9:00-4:30 daily and is open to students ages 14-17 who have had previous training and experience in vocal music, instrumental music or visual arts. Students will attend and participate in *all* camp activities, including a performance on the last day of camp, and will be expected to lead activities in their area of experience.
- Students who are mature, responsible, creative, enthusiastic, and show initiative will be accepted in the following three categories: vocal music, instrumental music and visual arts. Application Forms of interested students should be received by the studio no later than April 15. Students who meet the requirements will be asked to come in for an audition/interview. Payment for students accepted into the program will be due no later than May 31.
- Attendance and participation in all rehearsals and camp activities is mandatory for students accepted into this program.
- Limited spaces are available, and preference will be given to students who have attended previous SMS programming.

Vocal Music Apprenticeship: This student will have vocal training and performance experience. This student will be asked to warm-up, rehearse, and coach students as needed. Leadership Skills and a basic knowledge of proper breathing technique, support, and tone placement are required.

Instrumental Music Apprenticeship: This student will have training and performance experience in at least one of the following: piano, ukulele/guitar, recorder, or percussion instruments. This student will be asked to warm-up, rehearse, and coach students as needed. Leadership Skills and a basic knowledge of technique, music reading and/or chord symbols are required.

Visual Arts Apprenticeship: This student will have training and experience in at least one area of visual

arts. This student will be asked to coach students as needed. Leadership Skills, creativity and a basic knowledge of visual art technique are required.
