- The camp is designed to give training in Leadership Skills, Voice (speech & singing), Movement & Body Awareness, Improvisation, and Character Development through the rehearsing, and performance of a musical.
- The program runs daily is open to students ages 14-17 who wish to learn leadership skills alongside voice, dance and drama skills in a fun environment.
- Students will attend and participate in all rehearsals and camp activities, including a precamp workshop and a performance on the last day of camp.

The camp will run Monday-Friday, July 2-11, from 9:00-4:30 at 1555 Sydenham Road, Kingston with a required PreCamp Workshop on Sunday, June 1 from 2:00-5:00

Apprenticeship Camp Program:

\$200 per student- includes the pre-camp workshop. Students will receive 25-30 volunteer hours and a written evaluation as a part of this program.

Applications are due April 15

- This program runs from 9:00-4:30 daily and is open to students ages 14-17 who have had previous training and experience in one of the three musical theatre disciplines or backstage arts, and who wish to develop skills in the additional areas. Students will attend and participate in *all* camp activities, including a musical performance on the last day of camp, and will be expected to lead activities in their area of experience.
- Students who are mature, responsible, creative, enthusiastic, and show initiative will be accepted in the following four categories: voice, drama, dance, and backstage arts. Application Forms of interested students should be received by the studio no later than April 15. Students who meet the requirements will be asked to come in for an audition/interview. Payment for students accepted into the program will be due no later than May 31.
- Attendance and participation in all rehearsals and camp & precamp activities is mandatory for students accepted into this program.
- Limited spaces are available, and preference will be given to students who have attended previous SMS programming.

Voice Apprenticeship: This student will have vocal training and performance experience. This student will be asked to warm-up, rehearse, and coach students as needed. Leadership Skills and a basic knowledge of proper breathing technique, support, and tone placement are required.

Drama Apprenticeship: This student will have dramatic training and performance experience. This student will be asked to warm-up, rehearse, and coach students as needed. Leadership Skills, a

willingness to challenge themselves and take artistic risks, and a basic knowledge of theatrical approaches and techniques are required.

Dance Apprenticeship: This student will have dance training and performance experience in ballet, jazz, and/or musical theatre. Other types of dance experience may also be appropriate. This student will be asked to warm-up, rehearse, and coach students as needed. Leadership Skills and a basic knowledge of dance positions, common steps, and body awareness are required.

Backstage Apprenticeship: This student may or may not have training and experience working in the backstage arts, but must have leadership and organizational skills. This student will be asked to help make, organize, tidy, maintain, and keep track of costumes and props.
